Project Title: Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Measures Technical Expert Panel

Project Overview:

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) contracted The Lewin Group (Lewin) to develop and maintain a standard set of HCBS measures. The contract name is *Home and Community Based Services Measure Development, Endorsement, Maintenance, and Alignment*. The contract number is HHSM-500-2014-00033I, task number 75FCMC19F0004. As part of its measure development process, Lewin convenes groups of stakeholders and experts who contribute direction and thoughtful input to the measure developer during measure development and maintenance.

HCBS provides opportunities for individuals to receive services in their own home or community rather than institutions or other isolated settings. These programs serve a variety of targeted population groups, such as older adults, individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities, individuals with physical disabilities, individuals with acquired brain injuries, and/or individuals with mental health and substance use disorders (MH/SUD). As part of its measure development process, Lewin will convene groups of stakeholders and experts for two distinct technical expert panels that will contribute direction and input during the development and maintenance lifecycle of measures covered under this scope of work. The HCBS technical expert panel will support maintenance of a set of existing measures and help develop new measures appropriate for HCBS. Lewin will also seek relevant input through focus groups and key informant interviews.
