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**Project Title:** Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Measures Technical Expert Panel (TEP)

**Dates:** This project is anticipated to continue through September 2024.

**Project Overview:**

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) contracted with The Lewin Group (Lewin) to develop and maintain a standard set of HCBS measures through project number HHSM-500-2014-000331, task number 75FCMC19F0004, entitled *Home and Community Based Services Measure Development, Endorsement, Maintenance, and Alignment Contract*. HCBS provide opportunities for individuals to receive services in their own home or community rather than institutions or other isolated settings. These programs serve a variety of targeted population groups, such as older adults, individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities, individuals with physical disabilities, individuals with an acquired brain injury, and/or individuals with mental health and substance use disorders (MH/SUD). As part of its measure development process, Lewin will convene groups of stakeholders and experts for two distinct TEPs that will contribute direction and input during the development and maintenance lifecycle of measures covered under this scope of work. The HCBS TEP will support maintenance of a set of existing measures and help develop new measures appropriate for HCBS. Lewin will also seek relevant input through focus groups and key informant interviews.
