Project Title: Development of Preventive Cancer Screening & Counseling Patient-Reported Outcomebased Performance Measure (PRO-PM)

Project Overview:

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has contracted with Yale New Haven Health Services Corporation Center for Outcomes Research and Evaluation (YNHHSC/CORE) to develop a PRO-PM to assess preventive screenings for select cancers. The intent of the measure is to incentivize highquality clinician counseling related to preventative cancer screening and to reduce disparities in screening for disadvantaged individuals and populations. The measure will apply to clinicians who are eligible to participate under the Merit-based Incentive Payment System (MIPS) and will use data collected from patients. The contract name is Development, Reevaluation, and Implementation of Outcome/Efficiency Measures, Option Period 2. The contract number is HHSM-75FCMC18D0042, Task Order Number HHSM-75FCMC19F0002.

As part of its measure development process, CORE convenes groups of stakeholders and experts who contribute direction and thoughtful input to the measure developer during measure development and maintenance. This Clinician Committee, comprising clinicians and professional society representatives, will provide input on measure development decisions, including design of the patient survey instrument, data collection methodologies, risk-adjustment approaches, and performance measure calculations from the perspective of the frontline healthcare workers for whom the measure will be most relevant.
